Air Force Command Chief Master Sgt. Stuart M. Allison is the Defense Commissary Agency's senior enlisted adviser to the director. He is responsible for advising the DeCA director on enlisted service members' needs related to the commissary benefit and serving as the agency liaison with the senior enlisted chiefs of the armed services.

Chief Allison entered the Air Force in December 1992 as an inventory management specialist. He has held a variety of wing and command positions throughout the continental United States and overseas. In 2006, he served four months in Kirkuk Air Base, Iraq, as a supply superintendent for the 506<sup>th</sup> Expeditionary Logistics Readiness Squadron during Operation Iraqi Freedom. From November 2009 to September 2010, Chief Allison was a senior enlisted adviser for the Afghan National Army, Logistics Command, in Kabul, Afghanistan, during Operation Enduring Freedom. For three months in 2012, he served as a squadron superintendent for the 376<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron, Transit Center at Manas, Kyrgyzstan, and from July 2013 to January 2014, he served as a superintendent with the 407<sup>th</sup> Expeditionary Group in Jordan.

Prior to assuming his current position, Chief Allison served as superintendent, 509th Mission Support Group, Whiteman Air Force Base, Mo.
