Chief Master Sergeant Wayne B. Jones is the Defense Commissary Agency's senior enlisted advisor for DeCA's Europe Area, headquartered at Kapaun Air Station, Germany. He is responsible for advising the Europe area director on service members' needs related to the commissary benefit and serves as the agency's liaison with installation leaders. His area of responsibility encompasses 33 stores in 10 countries.

Prior to his DeCA assignment, Chief Jones was Chief Enlisted Manager for Air Force Global Strike Command, Nuclear Control Point at Kirtland Air Base, New Mexico. He enlisted in the Air Force in late December, 1991, and his background includes various duties in nuclear maintenance roles at the squadron, wing and major-command level, to include the Wing Weapons Safety Manager. Throughout his career he has filled a myriad of roles including additional-duty First Sergeant. His assignments include bases in New Mexico, Greece, England, Louisiana, California and North Dakota. He has worked with a variety of weapon systems which include gravity bombs, cruise missiles and the Minuteman III Intercontinental Ballistic Missile. Chief Jones has also served as the Weapons Safety Manager in Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan and Squadron Superintendent at F.E. Warren Air Force Base, Wyoming.
